The Royal Show celebrates its 160th anniversary in 2011 and any visit to this long-standing event promises to afford a pleasing and educational experience for all.

Aside from the broad mix of displays and demonstrations, the anticipated 2000 livestock on site and the presence of virtually all tractor and implement manufacturers, the following entertainment programme has been scheduled:

| Friday, 27 May | Official opening by the premier, Dr Mkhize, followed by a full SANDF military tattoo and a grand celebratory fireworks display |
| Saturday, 28 May | A 60 minute nostalgic concert with SA legends Bobby Angel, Dennis East and Billy Forrest, followed by a further military tattoo and a Johnny Clegg concert with a repertoire catering for all ages |
| Sunday, 29 May | The SA national chainsaw racing team, followed by the RSG concert and the final military tattoo. |
| Friday, 3 June | SA national dog agility championships, followed by horse racing demonstrations overseen by Gold Circle. |
| Saturday, 4 June | A one-off and very special 90 minute display of rally and stunt driving, followed by the Eastern Extravaganza concert in the evening |

Although the Royal Show runs for 10 days from Friday, 27 May to Sunday, 5 June, the final Sunday caters exclusively for the Ukhozi FM Zulu concert. Accordingly, visitors are respectfully reminded that as displays are in 'run down mode' and there will be no livestock on site at this time; this is not a good day to experience all that the show has to offer.
