PLEASE NOTE:

The onus is on the farmer to ensure that his/her animals are fed and watered for the duration of the period that they are at the Showgrounds up until they are loaded on Sunday afternoon 30 May, for transporting to the abattoir.

The Champion, the 1st Reserve, the 2nd Reserve and the Champion Group of 3 (of 4 entered) will be on display in the refrigerated show cabinet in the Sheep Expo during the afternoon of Wednesday 2 June, with the auction taking place at 16h30. The carcasses will be removed for delivery to buyers on Thursday 3 May.

COMMERCIAL CATTLE SECTION REGULATIONS

- 1. Ownership**

All animals entered in the Commercial Cattle section must have been owned by the exhibitor for at least three months prior to the first day of the Show.
- 2. The Entry Classes**
 - 2.1 The classes that are set out on the following pages are in the order in which they will be judged and those that will be judged in pens are indicated as such.
 - 2.2 Temporary pens will be erected in the cattle arena with adjacent facilities for off-loading, weighing and mousing.
 - 2.3 **Entries are limited to a maximum of 4 groups of 4 per exhibitor. However, an exhibitor may enter livestock under both the farm name and that of the exhibitor.**
- 3. Arrival date and times**
 - 3.1 Animals exhibited in the Commercial Cattle section must be delivered to the Showgrounds **no earlier** than 13h00 on Friday 28 May and **no later** than 07h00 on Saturday 29 May.
 - 3.2 **All stock entered in the Commercial section should be eartagged prior to arrival at the Showgrounds. Catalogue numbers will be given to exhibitors in advance.**
 - 3.3 All stock will be weighed and mouthed by the Society's officials.
 - 3.4 The temporary pens for the unhaltertrained animals will be provided.
 - 3.5 Supervision (but not feeding) of the unhaltertrained animals will be provided by the Society during the nights of Thursday 27, Friday 28 and Saturday 29 May.
- 4. Judging of the Champion Commercial Animal**
 - 4.1 The first and second prize winners in each of the Classes 2 and 3 will be brought forward to the judging of the Champion.
 - 4.2 All stock will compete on an equal footing in the Block Test Competition at Triple A Abattoir.
- 5. Cross entry restrictions**
 - 5.1 Entries in the Students Challenge class must be cross entered from the individual Class 2.
 - 5.2 School going children may NOT enter the Future Farmers Competition or Student's Challenge.
- 6. Control of animals**

All animals competing in this section must be kept under control at all times and exhibitors must take whatever precautions may be necessary to prevent their animals from breaking loose.
- 7. Block Test Competition**
 - 7.1 The judge will be responsible for all the Block Test awards including, at his discretion, Royal Show 'Merit Award' certificates.
 - 7.2 The Merit Award certificates will become the property of the purchasers of the carcasses and will not be retained by the exhibitors.
 - 7.3 Any animal which, subsequent to the live judging, is found to have cut a tooth on its arrival at the Abattoir will not be eligible for the Champion and Reserve Champion Carcass awards.
- 8. Limitation on entries**

In the event of excessive entries being received for the Commercial Cattle section, the Committee reserves the right to limit exhibitors. Should this action be necessary, exhibitors will be notified as soon as possible and entry fees paid will be refunded in respect of any entries that are not accepted. Also see point 2.3.

- Uniformity of dress of the leaders of each group is requested and the name of the University or College on the leaders' dress is permitted, to the exclusion of any other form of advertising, in the judging ring.
- The class will be judged prior to the individual classes for haltertrained animals.

Youth Show Competition Regulations

1. The cattle entered must be free of CA and be from a herd testing negative for Tuberculosis (TB). Heifers must have had calfhooed vaccinations (between 4 and 6 months). Please bring proof.
2. **In the event of entrants receiving an official cap, this cap must be worn at all times in the show ring and at prize giving, as well as for official photographs. No photos of prize winners will be published if the sponsor's/official cap is not worn.**
3. All cattle entered must be between the ages of 4 and 24 months. The heifers may not have completed their 24th (twenty-fourth) month. The Committee reserves the right to request age records from the owner of the animal.
4. **No bull calves may be entered.**
5. Heifers must be dehorned.
6. The age of the entrants/handlers is taken as the age on 1 January of that year.
7. The KZN Youth Show Committee shall have the right to refuse any entry made and shall not be bound to give reasons for doing so.
8. All entries are to be submitted in writing according to the details on the entry form.
9. All entries must be accompanied by an indemnity form signed by the parent or legal guardian.
10. All persons exhibiting shall accept the decision of the judges appointed by the Committee as to the merits of their exhibits, which decision will be final.
11. All exhibitors and their animals shall be accompanied by an adult.
12. The Committee reserves the right to adjust the classes / prizes according to entrant numbers.
13. Any query / complaint should be submitted in writing to the Committee and shall be accompanied by a fee of R100. On resolution of the enquiry in the favour of the complainant, the money shall be refunded to the complainant. In the event of the enquiry being upheld, the fee shall be donated to the Youth Show funds.
14. The Committee reserves the right to allow entrants to share animals.
15. The organisers will not accept any liability for the safety of the entrants or the animals.

FUTURE FARMERS' COMPETITION REGULATIONS

1. Age Restrictions

The competitors are restricted to matriculants and men and women up to 30 years of age as at 30 May 2010. **NO** cross entry of school-going children into the Future Farmers' competition.

2. Entry Requirements

- 2.1 Competitors are required to complete and return the entry form, together with their payment for the entry fees, **prior to the commencement of the competition.**
- 2.2 Competitors are encouraged to enter a Showing class and the Judging class but if they prefer, may enter the Showing classes only.

3. Briefing of Competitors

Competitors are required to report to the Chief Cattle Steward's office for briefing half an hour prior to the commencement of the competition.

4. The Judging Class

- 4.1 The competitors will be required to judge 5 head of cattle, placing them from 1st to 5th. They will record their reasons for their placings and will be marked accordingly.
- 4.2 The cattle will parade for 4 minutes and stand for inspection for 4 minutes.
- 4.3 When all judging is completed, the competitors will have 30 minutes to enter their placings and comments on the form provided at the briefing.

5. The Showing Classes

- 5.1 Each competitor is required to present him or herself for the Showing class with an animal of any breed older than 1 year.
- 5.2 The animal may be owned by the competitor or borrowed. The animal need not be registered.

6. Prize Giving

The prizes for the competitors will be presented at an informal function in the cattle arena following the conclusion of the competition.

7. Classes

The organisers reserve the right to amend classes as necessary.

- (G) **The Barry Crookes Memorial Floating Trophy**, awarded to the exhibitor gaining the most points in the numbered individual classes for Red Angus.

LIVESTOCK EXHIBITORS

1. Entries

- 1.1 All entries must be made on the prescribed form and must be accompanied by the correct entry fees (which are inclusive of VAT) by no later than the advertised closing date of entries.
- 1.2 The Committee reserves the right to refuse to accept any entry if the information contained therein is incomplete or if the entry is not accompanied by payment of the fees in full.
- 1.3 The name of the exhibitor of an animal as published in the Show Catalogue shall be that individual or company in whose name the animal was registered as at the closing date of entries.
- 1.4 The breeder of an animal is the owner of the dam at the time of birth.

2. Restriction on entries

- 2.1 In the event of excessive entries being received, which are in excess of the accommodation available in the section, the Committee reserves the right to restrict entries at its entire discretion by means of a quota system applicable to one or more breeds, or to such exhibitors as may be necessary.
- 2.2 In the event of it proving necessary to implement such a quota system, the exhibitors concerned will be notified in writing to this effect as quickly as possible after the closing date of entries.
- 2.3 Entry fees paid in respect of those animals that are not accepted for the Show will be refunded in full.

3. Judging

- 3.1 All persons exhibiting shall accept the decision of the judge appointed by the Society as to the merits of their exhibits, which decision shall be final.
- 3.2 The Committee reserves the right to set certain minimum requirements relating to the number of entries prior to approval being given for the conduct of a National or Provincial/Regional Championship Show at the annual Show.
- 3.3 None but bona-fide owners of stock or manufacturers of produce exhibited will be eligible to compete for prizes.
- 3.4 The judge/s shall not disqualify breeding stock for blemishes except hereditary ones. Exhibits of small stock on show must be free from external parasites otherwise the exhibit may be disqualified.
- 3.5 The judge will be required to screen all small stock during judging to determine the age and growth of wool. If any animal does not comply it will be disqualified and the exhibitor shall have no legal or other redress against the judge or the Society.
- 3.6 Exhibitors are required to make available the birth notification/registration certificates of their animals to the stewards, if requested by the stewards.
- 3.7 Unless otherwise stated in judging Championships, the first and second of the respective classes shall be paraded.
- 3.8 All prize awards will only be made provided sufficient merit obtains, at the sole discretion of the judge.
- 3.9 Where applicable, exhibits on the Show must be accompanied by the number that identifies it for the class in the Show catalogue or entry list. The catalogue number must be displayed at the time of judging, strictly in accordance with the requirements of each section.
- 3.10 Any animals brought out to be judged bearing a prize ticket or rosette shall be liable to disqualification. No prize card awarded by this Society (or any other Society) in previous years may be exhibited on any exhibit or stall at any time. Only prize tickets awarded at the current Show may be displayed in the stalls or in the parades.
- 3.11 Any exhibitor who-
 - Neglects to leave the judging ring at the request of the stewards while his animals are being judged;
 - Attempts to interfere with or influence the judges while in the discharge of their duties; or
 - Uses contemptuous language to, or about, any of the judges in consequence of an award made by them -shall either have his exhibits disqualified or shall forfeit his right to any prize to which he might otherwise be entitled, as the Committee may decide.

4. Group classes

- 4.1 Unless otherwise provided in any special conditions, the exhibitor of a progeny group must be the owner at the time of entry.
- 4.2 ALL animals competing in group classes MUST also be entered into the open classes. Where a young animal, which is not eligible for entry in the open classes, is brought in to make up a group, an extra entry fee must be paid.

5. Parade

Exhibitors in the livestock sections are required to bring forward their animals for all parades in accordance with the directives issued by the Chief Stewards and in accordance with the times intimated in the Show catalogue or as otherwise stated.

6. Objections

- 6.1 Any exhibitor in the Cattle, Sheep and Goat sections of the annual Show wishing to lodge an objection, having reference to any exhibit or to any award to any exhibit in these sections, may do so.
- 6.2 The objection must be submitted in writing, accompanied by a R100 deposit to the Society's General Manager, or to his authorised deputy, at the Society's office before 17h00 on the evening of the day on which the cause of the objection arises.
- 6.3 The objection shall be investigated within 24 hours of the occurrence by a sub-committee appointed by the Committee which shall include, but will not be limited to, the Chairman, the Vice-Chairman (if any) and the Chief Steward/s of the section concerned. The findings of the sub-committee shall be final and binding on all parties and the exhibitor submitting the objection shall be offered no right of appeal against the decision of the sub-committee.
- 6.4 The sub-committee shall not be required to give any reasons or explanations relating to its final decision.
- 6.5 If the objection is not substantiated by the sub-committee, the deposit of R100 shall be forfeited to the funds of the Society.
- 6.6 Should any exhibit, which has gained a prize be disqualified, the next in line does not necessarily obtain the same prize. The sub-committee, with or without the advice of the judge, shall decide the question.

7. Most Points

Most points will be scored by the highest placed five exhibitors in the individual classes with 5 points for 1st place, 4 points for 2nd place and so on to 1 point for 5th place, irrespective of the number of animals entered in the class.

GENERAL REGULATIONS

8. Powers of the Committee

- 8.1 The word 'Committee' in these General Regulations and elsewhere in the Prize List or Catalogue refers to the Executive Committee of the Royal Agricultural Society of Natal and to such other Committees of the Society to which the Executive Committee may delegate specific duties and powers.
- 8.2 The Committee shall have the right of refusing any entry made and shall not be bound to give any reason for so doing.
- 8.3 The Committee shall have the power to withhold the whole or part of the prizes offered by the Society in the event of there being no competition, or the exhibits being considered by the judges unworthy of such prize.
- 8.4 The Committee is empowered to introduce such regulations and procedures for the smooth running of the annual Show as it shall deem fit, subject to exhibitors being notified of such regulations through the medium of the Prize Lists or other publications, or by means of circulars.
- 8.5 The Committee is empowered not only to decide whether or not the annual Show shall be held, but is also entitled at any time in its absolute discretion to cancel, vary or alter any or all arrangements which may have been made in connection with the holding of the annual Show.

9. Loss or Destruction of Goods

- 9.1 No claim whatsoever shall lie against the Royal Agricultural Society arising out of the theft of, loss or damage to the property of any person or association of persons on premises falling under the

control of, owned or leased by the Royal Agricultural Society irrespective of the cause of such theft, loss or damage.

- 9.2 The Royal Agricultural Society is hereby indemnified and held harmless against any and all claims, at the instance of any person or association or persons, which may arise out of the theft, loss or damage aforementioned.

10. Public Liability Insurance

The Society's Public Liability Insurance Policy does not cover exhibitors. It is in the interests of exhibitors therefore, to obtain their own Public Liability Insurance cover for the Show period.

11. Prize Money

Monetary prizes will either be transferred electronically to a bank account provided by the exhibitor or posted to all successful exhibitors as soon as possible after the conclusion of the annual Show.

12. Responsibilities of Exhibitors

12.1 Each exhibitor shall be solely responsible for the description submitted in the entry form for inclusion in the catalogue of any animal exhibited by him.

12.2 Each exhibitor shall be solely responsible for any consequential or other injury, loss or damage to, occasioned by, or arising from any animal or article and shall indemnify the Society against legal or other proceedings in regard thereto.

12.3 Any person who shall bring any diseased animal of any kind to the Show shall be liable to a fine of R2 000 and shall be disqualified from receiving any of the benefits of the Society.

12.4 Whilst every reasonable care will be taken of exhibits, no responsibility or legal liability whatsoever shall be incurred by the Society, which shall under no circumstances be liable for any loss, damage or injury to any exhibits.

12.5 All cattle entered for the Show must be provided with a halter, except where specifically stated. One attendant at least must be present on behalf of each exhibitor in the horse, cattle, sheep and goat sections. All attendants must be subject to the orders of the stewards.

12.6 No fire may be lit in the Showgrounds except in those areas designated by the Committee. Any person infringing this regulation will be held responsible for any damage that may arise. In the case of employees, their employers will be held responsible.

13. Misrepresentation

13.1 Awards obtained by exhibitors at the annual Show may be advertised by exhibitors, providing that such advertising relates specifically to the entry which appeared at the Show and which received the prize(s) referred to in the advertisement.

13.2 Exhibitors are prohibited from issuing misleading or confusing advertisements which suggest, inter alia, that all their products are on a par with the particular product or sample of that product which they exhibited at the Show or that the overall quality of their herd or stud is equivalent to that of the animal(s) which they exhibited and which received recognition at the Show.

13.3 Any exhibitor contravening this regulation may have his entry for the following year refused by the Committee.

14. Control of dogs

14.1 Under no circumstances will dogs be permitted in any part of the Members' Enclosure or Grandstand, including the Society's office complex.

14.2 Elsewhere on the Showgrounds all dogs must be kept on a leash at all times.

15. Membership of the Society

15.1 Application for membership forms may be obtained at the Society's offices by those exhibitors who wish, by joining the Society, to make use of the privileges of free admission to the grounds, car parking and use of the members' facilities.

15.2 The membership year commences on 1 January and annual subscriptions are payable in advance.

16. Alteration to Regulations

These regulations are subject to alteration and amplification from time to time, at the discretion of the Society.
