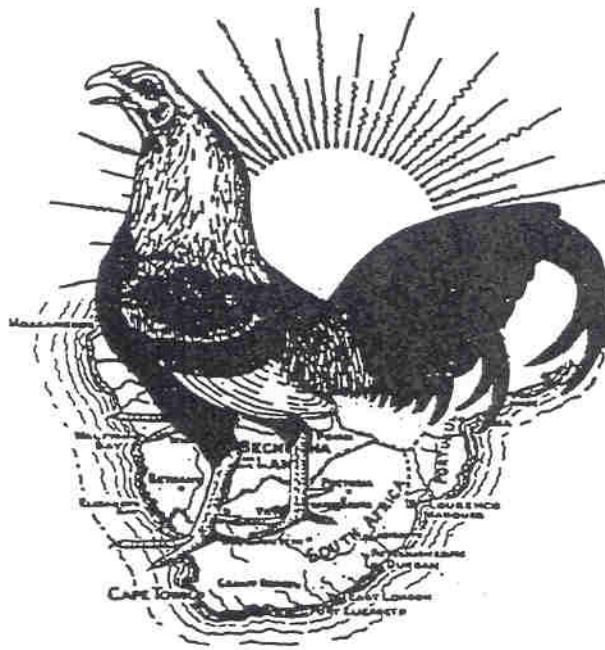

THE COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO APPOINT JUDGES OR TO CHANGE JUDGES AS REQUIRED.

SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The show is run according to SASPO rules and regulations.
2. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to complete his/her entry form correctly. **The show committee will not be held responsible for any mistakes arising from an incorrectly completed or illegible entry form.**
3. No exhibits may be entered in more than one class.
4. All sales are to be by the exhibitor to the buyer and the exhibitor must remove the exhibit from the hall at the time of release.
5. Breed classes will be provided for any breed entered in AOV classes, but not for additional colour varieties of a breed for which classes have already been provided. Exhibits entered in AOV classes must have a standard in the SASPO standards. Any standards not provided for must have been approved by SASPO before the show.
6. All exhibits must be benched by the time advertised in this show schedule. The committee has the right to refuse exhibits arriving after this time.
7. Pens will be provided for the exhibition of poultry and waterfowl. Exhibits will be fed, watered and attended to during the show. Every possible care will be taken to ensure the safety of exhibits, but the committee will not, under any circumstances, accept responsibility for loss or damage to exhibits.
8. No exhibit may, under any circumstances, be removed from its pen by anyone, except a steward, unless authorised by the show manager. During the show the exhibits are in the custody of the committee and may not be touched or handled by exhibitors or unauthorised persons.
9. Anything not covered by the foregoing rules shall be decided by the committee, whose decision in all cases, will be final. They also reserve themselves the right to the final interpretation in respect of any imperfectly worded rule or regulation.

SCHEDULE OF AWARDS

PRIZE CARDS will be awarded for first, second, third and fourth places. Highly commended may be awarded in lieu of fifth place should the number of entries justify it.

BREED CHAMPION AND RESERVE BREED CHAMPION will be awarded to the best and runner up in the respective breeds.

BEST AND RESERVE OF VARIETY will be awarded to the best and runner up in respective colour varieties, as well as to the best and reserve breeding pens and teams.

PRIZE MONEY will be awarded as follows:

50% of the entry fees received will be divided by the number of First prize winners, i.e. only first prize winners will receive prize money, irrespective of the number of entries in the class.

THE COMMITTEE MAY AWARD ANY ADDITIONAL PRIZES WHICH WILL BE ANNOUNCED BEFORE JUDGING.

THE JUDGES' DECISION WILL BE FINAL AND HE/SHE MAY WITHHOLD ANY AWARD AT HIS/HER DISCRETION.
